Lord's day: this is the Christian day of worship, the first day of the week, the day of Christ's resurrection (see Acts 20:7; 1 Cor 16:2). Only in Revelation 1:10 in the New Testament is the expression *the Lord's day* used, but it is found in early Christian literature: *Didache* 14 (the end of the first century), and Ignatius' *Letter to the Magnesians* 19 (early second century). The same adjective that is translated *the Lord's* is used in the phrase "the Lord's Supper" (1 Cor 11:20). *A Handbook to The Revelation to John*

Make a point to assemble with the church each and every Lord's Day. Doing so enables you to, "*consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.*" (Hebrews 10:24–25)
