Greetings from Ukraine,

Seems impossible that another month has passed but time does seem to fly!! It's the beginning of fall and lots of beauty awaits us as God starts to give us so many colors and cooler weather! Brandon, Katie and Justus Price arrived on Sept. 2nd to be with us the next two weeks. Brandon taught "Biblical Exegesis" and we enjoyed having them so much. We had them over for dinner and discussed more details about them moving here August 2019 to join the teaching staff. Justus was so adorable and we got a huge kick out of watching him watch himself on a video Brandon had made of Justus' first year

During this time we also were blessed by a visit from Richard and Denise Baggett who have been involved with Ukraine for years. They are a wonderful couple who have blessed many lives in Ukraine with their generosity. We had them, Ron and Theresa on Sunday after church for lunch and all had such an inspiring visit. It is so great to fellowship with fellow Christians and the vast knowledge they can share. God is good!!! That same Sunday it was my turn along with one of our students to feed 5 orphans. The ladies at church take turns doing this so these orphans can be allowed to be with the church all day. The orphanage requires us to feed them if they stay a certain number of hours away from the orphanage. I made them "Texas" stew. It was really my mother's vegetable stew but I thought if I called it "Texas" stew they would think it was something special!! Jay Don said they did!! He had to serve them, as I had had to rush home after church to get our dinner ready for the other guests.

One of the things most churches like to do is to enjoy meals together that we call "potlucks". We have embraced that tradition at the Pozniaky congregation. The church really enjoys the fellowship after our time of worship. This past Sunday was one of those great times. We often have a number of the refugees come and enjoy this time as well. This gives us an opportunity to talk with them about the Lord. We have a number of the refugees that are coming each Sunday to our worship service. They seem genuinely happy to have found fellowship and strength after their lives being totally uprooted.

Ron Fox and I had the wonderful opportunity to have supper with Zhenya and Nastia in their home. They are very happy and proud newlyweds. They have rented their own apartment for now and wanted us to see it. Zhenya, one of our translators,

wanted us to see the beautiful table setting prepared by his lovely wife. Nastia works as a florist and makes some striking bouquets of flowers. We really enjoyed the evening spending time with them, visiting about their new family life, and getting to know them better.

We were also delighted to see the Rob Hindman family. They used to live and work in Kharkiev and were back in Ukraine visiting the church there. Before they flew out of Ukraine they were able to spend a couple of nights in our visiting teachers apartment. Rob taught some courses for us at UBI when we were down in Donetsk so it was nice to see them again. They have a lovely family.

I have several favorite courses that I teach. One of them is the one on Christian Marriage. We try to give our students a good understanding of the Biblical Foundation of Marriage, the pitfalls of looking at marriage from the world's point of view, and many other ideas on how to have a great marriage. The students really love this course and at the last day before the test they all were very eager to share what they had gotten out of the course and also gave me and Mary Lee a beautiful LOVE plaque with our picture on it. I really cherish times like this with our students. It reinforces the reason we have spent so many years in Ukraine training workers for the kingdom over here. I remind them that their notes will be useful tools in helping and counseling others before and after they get married.

In closing we would like to ask most sincerely for your prayers on behalf of Toma Maluga, daughter of Natasha and Sasha who are our co-workers and like family to us. Toma has been diagnosed with a serious lung condition and is now in Germany trying to find treatment. She is scared, sick and feeling so lonely. Natasha was with her for a week but because Toma has to stay there longer. Natasha is back in Ukraine. We plead for your prayers for this family not only for healing but for financial help if you can. Their expenses are going to be out of sight and we all want to help them in any way we can.
