Here is the latest report from Jesùs Amaya:

Sorry for the delay of my mail. I am bad at sending photos and I have to wait for my wife Tensy to help me with the photos and she has been with a lot of work because in Mexico the month of February is when they enroll in schools and in accounting they have a lot of work.

I received the money Tolar sent for Emily. Thank you all very much for thinking about my daughter. She is glad to know that you all thought of Her. I send you 2 photos of Emily's wedding.

I tell you about my trips:

On January 4 and 5 I was preaching in Monterrey. On January 30 and 31 we traveled to Frontera, Coahuila., My cousin Miguel Amaya died of cancer. They asked me to go preach at his funeral. He preached to the Church of Christ for 51 years. He died at 72 years old. He studied in Torreòn at the Biblical School. He preached some years in the city of Puebla and the last 40 years in Frontera, Coahuila. The congregation is in the Bellavista neighborhood. His children are the ones who helped me with their voices to record the CD of the hymnal.

From February 14 to 16 I was preaching in Benton, Arkansas.

I send photos of the event. It was a special event for couples.

In this month of February, I saw Brother Chris Frizel and Karl Jones in the congregation in Torreòn.

In the congregation of here, on Tuesday every week, I will be teaching homiletics so that the brothers learn to elaborate classes and sermons.

Greetings to all the brothers in Tolar and say thank you for your support.

Tell them that the car we have thanks to you has been very useful.

Whenever I travel, I know that Tensy will have to move without problems. In Mexico, insecurity for women has increased greatly when they leave home and have to go by truck or by taxi alone.
